POLICY ON OFFER OF AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE STUDENTS*

(Except Law Programmes)

For session 2021-2022

A: Merit Scholarship

The Uttaranchal University encourages scholarly aptitude in students. In order to recognize their academic excellence following scholarships are awarded to students who perform extremely well in their qualifying examinations.

Conditions:

The merit scholarship will be awarded to students on the basis of their performance in their qualifying examinations if, following conditions are met with.

- (i) All programmes/subjects of their qualifying examinations are cleared in first attempt.
- (ii) This scholarship is applicable for first year only; the students cannot claim the scholarship for subsequent years.
- (iii) There will be no rounding of CGPA or the marks in their qualifying, for example if a student achieves CGPA "8.99" it will be considered as 8.99 and will not be considered as 9.00 similarly, if a student achieves 89.99% it will not be considered as 90.00%

B: Uttarakhand State Domicile Scholarship

The Uttaranchal University awards 26% scholarship in Tuition Fee to Uttarakhand Domicile Students. 40% of seats for these students are reserved throughout all the programmes of the University. To claim this award of scholarship the student must carry a valid Domicile certificate (Original) of Uttarakhand State at the time of admission/counseling.

C: Sushila Devi Scholarship for Girls

The Uttaranchal University awards 10% Sushila Devi Scholarship for Girl students on net Tuition Fee applicable for complete course for UG/PG programmes subject to following conditions:

- (i) The Scholarship percentage will remain same for 'Uttarakhand' / 'All India' category.

D: Scholarship to the Wards of Defence Personnel

The Uttarakhand University awards 5% scholarship on net Tuition Fee to the son/daughter of defence personnel (including Para Military viz ITBP, CRPF, etc.) for complete course.

To claim this award of scholarship the student must carry a valid certificate (Original) of their father/mother at the time of admission/counseling.

1. In case of serving Defence Personnel

- (i) Dependent's card issued to the servicemen / A certificate issued by the Unit Head / C.O. of the servicemen
- (ii) ID card of the servicemen
- (iii) ID/Aadhaar card of the student

2. In case of retired Defence Personnel

- (i) Discharge certificate of the servicemen
- (ii) ID card of the Ex-Servicemen
- (iii) ID/Aadhaar card of the student

3. In case of deceased Defence Personnel in combat

- (i) Dependent's card issued to the servicemen / A certificate issued by the Unit Head /C.O. of the servicemen.
- (ii) ID/Aadhaar card of the student

E: Scholarship to the Alumni

The Uttarakhand University awards 10% scholarship on net Tuition Fee to the Alumni for first year only. To claim this award of scholarship the student must carry the following documents at the time of admission/counseling.

- (i) Aadhaar / Any valid photo ID proof of the student bearing the name of the parent.
- (ii) Mark sheet/Certificate issued to Alumni bearing the names of parents.

General Conditions

1. The student will not be entitled for more than one scholarship out of C, D and E as mentioned above. He/she may choose the best or whichever is higher and beneficial at the time of admission. Scholarship once chosen cannot be changed or interchanged with another scholarship in future.
2. The award of scholarship will be applied to the net Tuition Fee for scholarship type C, D and E only.
3. The eligible students are required to submit an affidavit duly signed by their parents/legal guardians accepting all the conditions of the offer of award of scholarship.
4. The University shall offer the scholarship on trust that all the documents are genuine and are not forged if, on a later stage it is found that the student has obtained scholarship on the basis of forged documents and false information then, the University will have a right to recover actual fee and may also initiate administrative action as per the decision by the Management against the concerned.
5. The above scholarships are not applicable for University's Law Programmes. The scholarships applicable to law programmes are mentioned separately.
6. The above-mentioned policies are applicable for students admitted in session 2021-2022 only.

***Note: For MBA (Corporate) programme, NO Scholarship will be applicable**
